

Cleaning Instructions for Wood Floors Finished with Polyurethane

It is important to keep sand and grit off your wood floor as this can cause premature wear. You're new wood floor will require regular vacuuming or sweeping along with the occasional dusting with a damp micro fiber mop.

For regular cleaning or spot cleaning we recommend LOBA's wood floor cleaner. It is a very mild, residential product that can be safely used in your home. LOBA cleaner uses an advanced formula specifically designed to clean all wood floors coated with a clear non-wax finish.* LOBA cleaner contains no surface dulling oils that collect dust and dirt, nor does it contain any waxy polishes to build up on the surface of your floor finish.

Avoid using floor care products with oils, waxes or any that say they will "leave a shine" on your floor. These products are meant for old, worn floors that are in need of some amount of refinish work. Your new floor only needs a cleaner that will remove dirt and grime without leaving and residues that make future recoating not possible.
